Job Description

Requirements:

- The ideal candidate must have completed an accredited Master's degree program that meets licensing requirements for the State of South Dakota.
- The ideal candidate must be licensed as an LPC, LPC-MH, or MFT to apply for this full-time position.
- The candidate must hold a Master's degree in counseling, psychology, social work, or a related field.
- Due to our needs and growing clientele, the ideal candidate has experience working with children and some experience in play therapy.

Responsibilities:

- The potential clinician will provide individual adults, families, children, adolescents, and couples with empathic support and diagnosis for mental health issues of various disorders using a “wellness” model.
